All College Dreamers need to:

- Fill out college application & submit by deadline
- FAFSA done and submitted to colleges (watch for “Financial Aid Verification” and “Data” forms from college)
- Apply for two scholarships and provide written proof
- Receive Financial Award Letter from college

To be submitted to IHAD College Coordinator in order to be eligible for funding
(Items must be turned in at LEAST 3 WEEKS before your tuition needs to be paid.)

- Copy SAR “Student Aid Report” (you can print this at the FAFSA website)
- Copy of Financial Award Letter from college
- Copies of written materials as proof of two scholarships applications
- Copy of high school transcript or GED certificate
- Copy of letter of admission from college with student ID # on it
- Schedule of classes for Fall Quarter or Semester
- Copy of a signed a “Release of Information” form at your college
- “I Have a Dream” Post High School Educational Goals Form

Specific to “New” Clark Students

- Take “Compass Placement Tests” (call Clark for testing schedule) You must have taken the placement tests before you register for classes.
- Meet with an Advisor (schedule registering for classes and attending orientation.)
- Sign “Clark Release of Information” form (Paul will have these for you to sign)
