



## **"I Have a Dream" of Southwest Washington**

### **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

#### **SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT POLICY**

##### **IHAD Scholarships**

After other scholarship, work study and grant money has been awarded, the "I Have a Dream" of Southwest Washington's financial assistance is limited to all remaining tuition money up to the level of Washington State University tuition at date of high school graduation.

##### **How and when are payments sent?**

Tuition assistance through "I Have a Dream" of Southwest Washington (IHAD) will be disbursed in accordance with the national IHAD policies and procedures. IHAD financial assistance is last dollar, forwarded to the institution/school after all other grants and scholarships are awarded and posted on the students account. IHAD assistance is applied prior to any loan that a student may elect to borrow.

##### **What is covered through the IHAD scholarship?**

Financial assistance through IHAD is for tuition only. Please be aware that the allotted amount is not carried over from one semester to another, nor to the following academic year. IHAD does not provide tuition assistance for classes students may elect to take for summer or interim sessions.

##### **Are there any additional eligibility requirements?**

To qualify for assistance, each student must apply for financial assistance through the FAFSA form, and to apply for other community scholarships for which they may be eligible. IHAD must receive a copy of all scholarship applications which each student has submitted.

##### **Paperwork Due**

All IHAD Scholarship Recipients are required to submit verification of registration, financial aid received and/or pending, and verification of tuition, housing, and meal plan cost to the IHAD office at least three weeks in advance of when payment is due. All paperwork must be submitted on official letterhead or other documentation of the institution/school.

##### **Are there any additional eligibility requirements?**

At the end of each semester, all IHAD Scholarship recipients are required to submit an updated transcript to the IHAD office. We have enclosed an "IHAD Transcript Request Form". NO TRANSCRIPT, NO ASSISTANCE.

It is also the student's responsibility to provide IHAD office with their current address.
